We want to remind coaches, athletes, and spectators that proper handwashing, sneezing or coughing into the elbow/arm, and self-monitoring are most important. If you are feverish or sick stay home and seek medical treatment.

Also please note that the doors will open to the venue 30 minutes before competition begins each day.
